I've always enjoyed the comic strip "BC." The author, Johnny Hart, was a Christian who was never shy about incorporating his faith into the comic. Christmas and Easter seasons were opportune moments for him to share what he believed. His comic insight would often bring a smile along with a touch of truth. His characters, set in the time before time, are nonetheless as current and relevant as ever.

Take this comic:



Why of all days would we call the Friday of Jesus' death Good Friday? The torture and brutality that Jesus endured physcially, the emotional turmoil of knowing that he was to die and the spiritual isolation that came when he took on our sins can hardly be called good. And yet, that is the miracle of our God. A God who can take death and bring life. A God who can transform a dark Friday into a Good Friday. A God who can and does alter lives. Consider the attitudes of those before and after Easter: Mary Magdalene, Peter, John, Thomas and the disciples on the road to Emmaus.

The author John Stott said that the resurrection is at the very heart of Christianity. If you remove it, Christianity is destroyed. Yes, Christ's resurrection is central to our faith. Four months ago, when we celebrated Jesus' birth, we reminded ourselves that Jesus being born in Bethlehem means little if he is not also born in our hearts and lives. Similarly, the resurrection continues to happen today in the lives of people who experience the transforming power of a God who can and does turn dark Fridays into Good Fridays!






